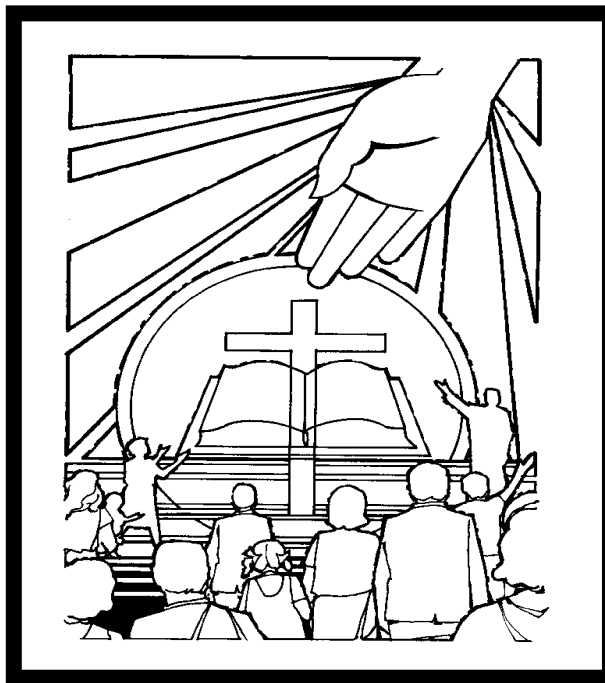

Now that the school year is beginning we are starting new routines.

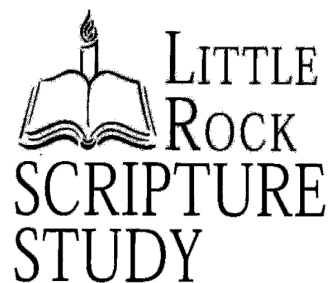
