Blessed Sacrament Chapel



In order to have a constant vigil of prayer before the Blessed Sacrament in our chapel, we must make sure that each hour is covered. Therefore, it is necessary for each person to commit himself or herself to a specific hour once a week, for example, Tuesday at 4 p.m. In this way, we can organize the 60 hours (Monday to Friday from 10am to 10 pm) in such a way that someone is with Jesus during these hours. The scheduled adorers are guardians of the Blessed Sacrament, so their presence is necessary.

Let us set aside one special hour each week to pray before the Blessed Sacrament. "In everything you do, put God first, and He will direct you and crown your efforts with success." (Prov.3:6)

What are the benefits of praying before the Blessed Sacrament? Each person that spends time in the presence of Jesus in the Most Blessed Sacrament grows in holiness. Through our Holy Hours of prayer, Our Holy Father declared that we are contributing to "the radical transformation of the world," the establishing of everlasting peace," and the coming of Christ's Kingdom on earth. Vatican 2 stressed the importance of lay involvement in the mission of the Church. Eucharistic Adoration is coordinated by the laity, in cooperation with the clergy.
